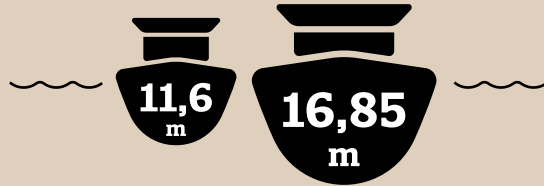

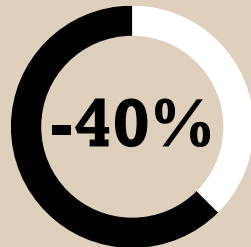
Dredging project overview
